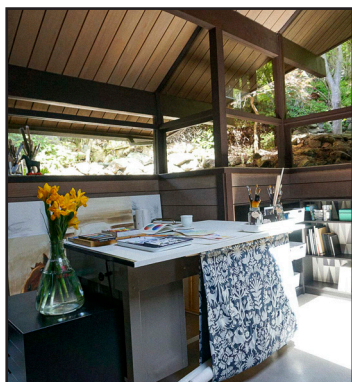
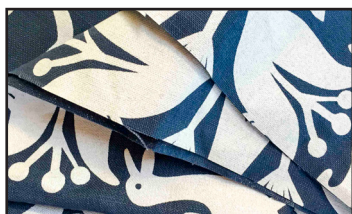


DIY: Fabric Sling

SUPPLIES:
2 YDS FABRIC (42" OR WIDER) WITH
MATCHING THREAD
2 - 1/2" WOODEN DOWEL RODS, CUT
TO 38" L EACH

LEVEL: ADVANCED
TIME: 2 HOURS

This is a great solution for storing oversized papers! It's also an opportunity to select a fun fabric to bring a punch of color into your office, studio, or craft room.



SELECT YOUR BULB. SELECT YOUR FABRIC. We used Navy Otomi fabric from Hygge & West. Cut fabric to 36" w x 72" l.

FOLD over about an inch of fabric on all sides; hem and press.

FOLD short ends over 2 inches and stitch to create a pocket for the dowels

INSERT DOWELS

MEASURE/MARK underside of desk/shelf for hooks

SCREW HOOKS into the underside of desk top/shelf

PLACE DOWELS into the screws

USE YOUR NEW SLING FOR STORAGE OF LIGHT MATERIALS (PAPER, FABRIC SCRAPS, ETC.)
